**Counted by hand using
a Kangaroo Board**

Using a Kangaroo Board involves counting ballots in multi-contest races like councillor by layering ballots so only the markings show and two counters counting across each candidate's row.



Single Contest Ballots

**Counted by hand using
the Sort and Stack Method**

Sort and Stack method counts ballots by sorting them into candidate piles in single-seat contests like mayor and counted twice.

Eligible Voters

The number of eligible voters is determined using the provinces shared register of electors that was updated this election within the voting stations.

A person is eligible to vote in an election held pursuant to the Local Authorities Election Act, if the person:

- a. is at least 18 years of age,
- b. is a Canadian citizen, and
- c. resides in Alberta and the persons place of residence is located in the local jurisdiction on election day.

Overvote

An overvote is when more than the permitted number of votes are cast on a ballot. For example: the ballot indicates to select a maximum of 8 candidates and the voter makes 9 selections. An overvote results in the ballot being rejected and the votes on that ballot are not counted for that office.

Undervote

An undervote is when less than the permitted number of votes are cast. For example: the ballot indicates to select a maximum of 5 candidates and the voter makes only 3 selections. This would result in 2 undervotes, all votes made are counted.

Voter Turnout

Voter turnout is the number of eligible voters who voted. To determine voter turnout, the number of total voters who voted is divided by the number of eligible voters. For the purposes of this report, the voter turnout is only calculated on elections held in The City of Red Deer's corporate boundaries.
