Note: Your completed nominations must be received by the Returning Officer during the nomination period starting January 1, 2021 up until 12 noon on nomination day, Monday, September 20, 2021. No emailed or faxed nomination forms will be accepted.

Ensure all candidate workers receive identification from the Returning Officer

Join us for the 2021 Election Reception to track the live election results

Within 48 hours of close of voting stations, remove all election signs and fill any resulting holes with a mix of topsoil and grass seed
