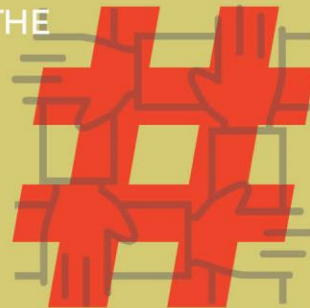

## DEFINITIONS

### Eligible Voters

The number of eligible voters is determined by using the City's most recent census data in conjunction with census data gathered by Statistics Canada.

A person is eligible to vote in an election held pursuant to the *Local Authorities Election Act*, if the person

- (a) is at least 18 years old,
- (b) is a Canadian citizen, and
- (c) resides in Alberta and the person's place of residence is located in the local jurisdiction on election day.

### Overvote

An overvote is when more selections have been made than the number permitted. For example: the ballot indicates to select a maximum of 8 candidates and the voter makes 9 selections. An overvote results in the ballot being rejected and the votes are not counted for that office.

### Undervote

An undervote is when less than the permitted number of votes are cast. For example: the ballot indicates to select a maximum of 4 candidates and the voter makes only 2 selections. This would result in two undervotes. All votes made are counted.

### Voter Turnout

Voter turnout is the number of eligible voters who voted. In order to determine voter turnout, the number of total voters who voted is divided by the number of eligible voters. For the purposes of this report, the voter turnout is only calculated on elections held in the City of Red Deer's corporate boundaries.
